The PE also wishes to clarify and make amendment/changes to various requests made.

	CLARIFICATION SOUGHT AND CHANGES TO TENDER	CLARIFICATION/AMMENDED REQUIREMENT
1.	Tender reference number	The tender reference numbers on pages i, x and 18 are all different. The procuring entity (PE) wishes clarify that the correct tender reference number is NSSF/ONT/SS/20/2025/26 . Bidders are advised to indicate this as the correct tender number.
2.	Clarification on Mandatory requirement item no. 6 on provision of KSIA Certificate and whether bidders can be allowed to provide PSIA certificate.	The PE has noted that both KSIA and PSIA are membership bodies. The request to provide PSIA has been considered and hereby allowed that the interested bidders may attach either or both PSIA and KSIA certificate.
3.	clarification on whether the prices to be submitted should be inclusive or exclusive of applicable taxes, particularly VAT,	All services and taxable, the price schedule clearly provide for submission of all applicable taxes. Interested bidders are therefore informed that the tender sum should be inclusive of all applicable taxes.
4	clarification on the mode of submission. Specifically, please confirm whether the tender is to be submitted electronically through the NSSF SAP portal only, or whether physical submission in two separate sealed envelopes (Technical and Financial Proposals) is also required, as the instructions appear to be contradictory.	On submission of tenders, interested bidders are referred to tender Data sheet. Electronic tenders are NOT applicable. The tender is submitted physically one original and one copy and in one envelope.

<p>Clarification regarding the eligibility requirements stated in the Tender Data Sheet.</p>	<p>The PE has provided two clusters in the tender. Cluster 1. Comprises of category A, B and C Cluster 2. Comprises of Category D, E and F Interested bidders are allowed to bid for a maximum of two categories. The allowed two categories has a disclaimer that they are NOT supposed to be in the same Cluster. Example; Bidders are NOT allowed to bid for category A and B but they are allowed to bid for category A and F. Biding for category A and B or Band C or A and C or D and E or E and F or D and F leads to disqualification. Note. Successful bidders can be awarded ONE category only.</p>
